




# **EGG-CITING MODELS - Y2 - 6**

**UNIFORM** Please ensure your child is in full school uniform. Procedures for children who arrive at school wearing non-school uniform clothing will be as following:

- 1. Teacher will give the child a gentle reminder about wearing the correct uniform
- 2. Teachers to send a message via Class Dojo to parents asking them to ensure their child is in correct uniform.
- 3. If no positive response from the Class Dojo message, refer to Interim Office Manager Mrs McMahon to send a letter home giving parents one week to rectify the issue.
- 4. Uniform policy sent home and a phone call from the office to discuss further.

## **BAGELS**
