Nursery, Reception and Year 1 children are invited to create a hat with their parent / carer together and bring in their Easter

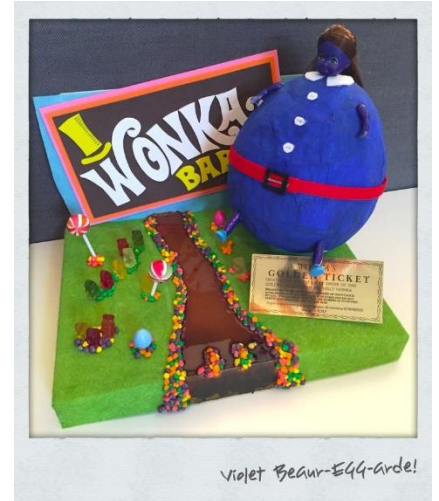

UNIFORM Please ensure your child is in full school uniform. Procedures for children who arrive at school wearing non-school uniform clothing will be as following:

1. Teacher will give the child a gentle reminder about wearing the correct uniform
2. Teachers to send a message via Class Dojo to parents asking them to ensure their child is in correct uniform.
3. If no positive response from the Class Dojo message, refer to Interim Office Manager Mrs McMahon to send a letter home giving parents one week to rectify the issue.
4. Uniform policy sent home and a phone call from the office to discuss further.
