UNIFORM

Trainers are not allowed to be worn. The uniform policy on the website, makes this very clear. PARENT COMMUNICATIONS

As this is our main form of communication, please regularly check messages and school story to keep up to date with your child's class.



LEAVE OF ABSENCE REQUESTS

We totally understand the lure of the cheaper holidays in school time, but please ensure these are taken in the school holidays. The children need to be in school learning and as a reminder, as a school, we are unable to authorise such requests

and therefore have to follow procedures and report absences to the LA, who may fine each parent /carer. The LA have made an increase to the rate of a penalty notice from £120 to £160 if paid within 28 days, and £60 to £80 if paid within 21 days. With any second penalty notice issued to the same parent for the same child within a rolling 3 year period, this will be charged at a higher rate of £160 with no option for this second offence to be discharged at the lower rate of £80.

BARRIER / CAR PARK

Parents are not allowed to use the car park, this means walking through or driving through. We are aware of parents following others through the barrier. It is getting very dangerous with too many people accessing the carpark. We fear that a child will be hurt so we have to take action. To be fair to all, only vehicles with blue badges will now be allowed through and these people will sign in through the video entry system that we are currently having fitted.

SPORTS MORNINGS



The weather can't make up it's mind at the moment, but it needs to brighten up as we are being Olympic athletes with our 'Road to Paris' topic and are looking forward to our Sports Mornings in the week beginning 24th June. The children compete in their PE kit in house colours, but will need to bring in trainers.

SCHOOL REPORTS

Teachers are busy writing your child's school report and these will go out on Monday 1st July for years N - 5 and Friday 12th July for Year 6, (following their High School Transition days and getting their SATs results back). Reports for N - 5 will be accompanied with a letter from your child's new teacher.



TRANSITION DAYS

We teach the children all about moving on in many different ways; through assemblies, stories and meet the teacher days. Year 6 should have already received separate days in July where they will be required to attend their new schools. All other classes will be having 2 transition days on Wednesday 3rd and Wednesday 10th July, where they will start and end with their own class teacher, but will be spending the day getting to know their new teacher, teaching assistant and lunchtime, learning and play leader for September 2024.

Books will be sent home the week beginning Mon 15th July for you to look at. We will have an **OPEN EVENING 3:30 – 5:30pm on Monday 8th July 2024** where no appointment will be necessary, but it will be a chance for you and your child to come and speak to your current teacher about the report and more importantly, say hello to your child's new class teacher and collect their plan for 2024 / 2025.
