Together with Mojo and our class dojo friends, these core values teach us how to learn.




#### **PARENT / CARER COMMUNICATIONS**

We are a 'Class-Dojo school' which means that this is main way to communicate with you and it also forms the basis of our reward system for pupils. Please see our Home-School Agreement regarding expectations for class dojo. <u>These</u> include that teachers are not required to reply out of school



<u>hours.</u> Please ensure you get the Class Dojo app on your phone. It is a great system and the main way we communicate with you by sharing important information, good news about your child, class stories and photos. Please check regularly for updates and if you are having trouble accessing the app on your phone, please come into the office, we are always happy to help.

During the week, children earn 'dojo' points for the following good choices. It is a great way of preparing them for modern Britain and managing their finances as each Friday, children can either 'spend or save' their points, when our dojo rewards trolley comes round.





A great way to start your morning here at Bushbury is with bagels, crumpets, a choice of cereals, fruit and juice and a chance to chat, play and exercise with your friends! We are kindly sponsored by Warburtons who provide us with crumpets and bagels as a community goodwill gesture. Our FREE Breakfast Club is for Reception to Year 6 children. Sadly, Nursery children cannot attend due to rules on ratios. Admission into the breakfast club is from 8:00am until 8:20am each morning. Remember parents and carers can drop off using the kitchen entrance or come in via the main office. Please do not leave your children unaccompanied before 8am.





Each child is allocated a Class Dojo 'house' and is given a PE kit in colour to match. Each year, the houses change according to the Summer 2 topic across the school, which in 2025 will be 'A piece of art', where we will get extra creative and contribute to a whole school piece of art. The children collect Dojo reward points for themselves and their house. The winning house each week is celebrated in assembly and the points are updated on the website to see who gets the most over the term.

#### **OUR SCHOOL HOURS**



Our school gates open at 8:35am for those not attending breakfast club. The gates close and lessons start at 8:45am. You are late after this point and this is recorded, so please make sure your child is an

attendance HERO - HERE EVERYDAY READY ON TIME. We finish now at 3:15pm.



#### ATTENDANCE TREASURE ISLAND

Good attendance is crucial for your child's learning, socialising and having fun, for both their education and their mental health and wellbeing. We track attendance and each term your child can get a bronze, silver or gold badge.





Each day as the children come in, they write their name on a raffle ticket which goes into their class pirate chest. Each week, these go into the school treasure chest and prizes are drawn. At the end of each term children have the chance of an even bigger prize! This December 3 lucky children will win a bike, complete with helmet! You've got to me in it to win it, so the more times they are here, the more chance of winning!

#### **HOMEWORK CHALLENGES**

You helping your child is the key to their success. Homework this year will take the form of reading challenges, learning key maths facts and spellings. Year 6 will have set weekly homework in preparation for their next steps to secondary school. TTRockstars and Numbots are online resources that the children can use at home to help their learning. They get certificates each week in celebration assembly for completing these challenges too.



#### PARENTS' OPEN EVENING – TUESDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 3:30 – 5:30

We will be having an open evening where you are welcome to come into school, view your child's work so far and chat to your teacher. No appointment is necessary, just choose when you would like to pop back up. It will be a chance to come into school and the children can show where their classroom is and where they sit. Come into the hall to meet the Reflexion team, the learning mentors and

sample the new winter menu we have from Miquills, who make our lunches.

#### **UNIFORM**

The children are looking super smart, thank you for adhering to the our uniform policy, available on our website - <u>https://www.bushburyhillprimary.co.uk/school-uniform</u> As a reminder, we do not allow anything other than all black shoes. If children arrive in incorrect uniform, these procedures will be followed

1. Breakfast Club staff or Teacher will send child to the office. A phone call will be made home and parents asked to bring the appropriate item of uniform. Child to wait for item to be delivered.

2. If parents cannot get to school with item, pupils will be required to borrow items for the day, which can be returned, so as to allow them to continue their learning.

3. Parents offered to purchase uniform from the pre-loved clothing rail.

Children in full school uniform are rewarded with dojo points.




#### MON 16<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER – SCHOOL PHOTO DAY
